



Frost Creek winter COVID operating procedures as of Monday, November 2, 2020.

We remind you to please:

- **Wash or sanitize your hands often**
- **maintain social distance (6 ft)**
- **bring a face cover to wear in the clubhouse**

Per the Eagle County Health Order dated 7/3/2020 face coverings are mandatory indoors. You may take off your face covering at your table in the restaurant.

1. Clubhouse open weekdays from 9am-4pm, weekends 10am-4pm.

- Locker rooms** open without towels, sharable toiletry items, showers, and bar snacks.
- Restaurant** Closed for the season. We will begin take and bake offerings on Monday, November 16th. Limited dine in service for Lunch and Dinner will be offered on Friday-Saturdays beginning Friday December 18th.
- Restaurant** Members and accompanied cabin guests only in the clubhouse this winter.
- Coffee and Tea are available.**
 - Please wash and hands and use hand sanitizer before using the air pots.
- Golf shop** open for retail during clubhouse hours.
- Fitness** open by reservation only. 50-minute reservations available to 1 household at a time. No guests. Reservations can be made through the online tee sheet. Toggle on the "course" option and choose fitness.
- Spa and spa locker rooms (including the steam room)** are closed. Restrooms are available for those who are working out.

2. Hot Tub

- The hot tub is open. Reservations are mandatory.
- One household or cabin in the hot tub per reservation.
- Hours of operation 8am-9pm. Last reservation is at 8pm.
- Reservations will be required** and are for 50 minutes every hour. For example, if you reserve the hot tub at 9am, you are done at 9:50am.
- Hot tub use will be restricted to members and cabin guests only.
- The locker rooms will be for restrooms only.
 - Please shower and get dressed to swim at home. (Showers are not available)
 - Please bring your own towels.
- You are responsible for the compliance of your children to all the policies while at the hot tub.

3. Other Activities

- a. Nordic skiing will be available when we have enough snow.
 - i. Skis/boots/poles are stored in the pool house and are first come first served.
 - ii. Gear is for members and accompanied cabin guests only.
 - iii. Please use sanitation station to wipe down any gear prior and after you use it.
- b. Skating will be available weather dependent.
 - i. Hockey and figure skates are stored in the pool house and are first come first served.
 - ii. Skates are for members and accompanied cabin guests only.
 - iii. Please use sanitation station to wipe down any gear prior and after you use it.
- c. Snowshoes.
 - i. Snowshoes are stored in the pool house and is first come first served.
 - ii. Gear is for members and accompanied cabin guests only.
 - iii. Please use sanitation station to wipe down any gear prior and after you use it.
- d. Sledding. The sledding hill will open when we have enough snow!
 - i. Sleds are stored at the top of the sledding hill (driving range) and are first come first served.
 - ii. Gear is for members and accompanied cabin guests only.
 - iii. Please use sanitation station to wipe down any gear prior and after you use it.
 - iv. No dogs on the sledding hill.

4. Children

- a. We ask you keep your children 12 and under with you at all times when you are inside any of the facilities. Please share these rules with your children. They can run around outside but should be with you when you are inside the clubhouse or on the dining patio.

5. Cabins

- a. The cabins are available for both short and long-term rental at full occupancy. Reservations can be made online or by contacting Carrie at 970-455-3074.
